1. Enter an established undergraduate or graduate school or graduate department for applications **as of April 1 of the year of the application (2012)**. (Including those which have closed student enrollment.)
2. Note correspondence courses.
3. Add a supplementary note to the Note column for undergraduate and graduate schools and departments which have opened admissions or changed names during the academic year of the application (2010).
4. Add a supplementary note in the Note column for undergraduate and graduate schools and departments which have closed student recruitment.
5. Enclose Professional Graduate School in parentheses and label relevant graduate school departments and courses as such.
6. Mark undergraduate and graduate schools and departments that have not completed an academic year as of April of the year of the application with (*1) and mark undergraduate and graduate schools and departments when the academic year in which qualification requirements are satisfied has not been reached (academic year +1 year) with (*2) and enter the year and month of student admission in the Note column.
7. Take note that the admission capacity cannot simply be calculated as the current admissions capacity x the standard term of study as a result of other factors such as changes to enrollment limits, acceptance of transfer students, students not yet completing their term of study and programs that have closed student enrollment.
8. Undergraduate schools and departments marked with *3 are undergoing application for approval from MEXT. Changes may occur to official names and other plans.
