- 1. Record a description of the faculty for each school, department, institute or other organization.
- 2. If there is an independent organization in charge of general education courses, foreign language courses, health and physical education courses or education courses, record the name of that organization in the "Other Organizations" column.
- 3. A full-time instructor is employed full-time at the university while a part-time instructor is employed from outside the university. At national universities both professors that have part-time duties and part-time employement in an organization are called part-time instructors, but only part-time employees from outside of the university should be included in the Part-Time Instructors column. Also include professors from associated junior colleges as part-time instructors.
- 4. Only guest professors, special professors (equivalent to full-time instructors as defined by their research conditions) and their equivalent should be included in the "Number of Full-Time Instructors" column under the "Professor," "Associate Professor," "Lecturer" and "Assistant Professor" columns. Other special instructors should be included in the "Special Term Instructor (Additional)" column.
- 5. Record the total of professors, associate professors, lecturers, and assistant professors in the "Number of Full-Time Instructors" column (A).
- 6. "Assistant" is defined as primarily persons employed in education and research. When there are full-time teaching assistants acting as support staff (such as junior assistants, laboratory assistants, etc.), teaching assistants, or research assistants, record the name of the position and number of staff members in the "Note" column.
- 7. When faculty are working full-time in a graduate school and the undergraduate courses are taught entirely through part-time instructor (concurrently held posts in the undergraduate school), enter the number of such faculty in the "Part-Time Instructor" column and count them as a part-time instructor when calculating the "Number of Enrolled Students per Full-Time Instructor". In this case, do not include part-time instructors from other schools or graduate departments in the "Part-Time Instructor" column.
- 8. Enter the "Establishment Standards Required Full-Time Instructors" for each graduate school and department established in the graduate university.

[Note: KG] Special term limited professors, full-time associate professors of English, full-time foreign national lecturers, full-time instructors of English, Japanese, Chinese and Korean language, and special contract instructors should be recorded as special term instructor (Additional).
