授業目的/Course Purpose	The course is intended to give an introduction to (a) the subject of Economic History as an independent academic subject, an overview (b) over the historical evolution of Europe as an economic entity and (c) the economic development of European regions and countries from the High Middle Ages until World War II. The course applies an economic historical approach with focuses particular on how living conditions of the population have changed due to Europe's economic development.
